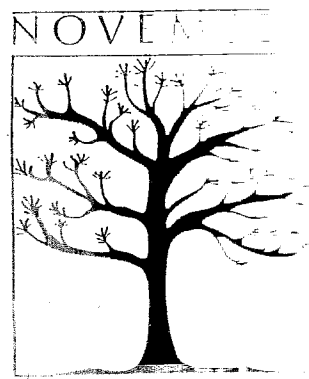

November 27	Basketball

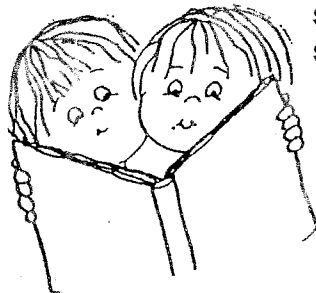
Please note that whenever the Hemlock schools close for bad weather then story hour is cancelled.
